



EPS Installation Guidelines

Thank you for purchasing an AAE EPS (Electric Power Steering) unit remanufactured by CRP Industries Inc.

Always refer to the vehicle manufacturer's repair manual for proper removal, installation and testing procedures. In the event, you do not have the necessary experience, tools or instructions for the procedure, you must request the services of an ASE certified technician.

Guidelines

- Avoid impact to any electronic parts such as the EPS motor assembly and the Electronic Control Unit (ECU).
- Do not pull on any wire harnesses when installing or moving the EPS unit.
- Steering gears must be centered to the correct pinion clock position before installation in the vehicle.
- Certain EPS units require calibration and/or programming. Please refer to the vehicle manufacturer's repair manual.
- Vehicle wheel alignment services may be required after replacing the EPS unit.
- Improper installation may result in hazardous steering operation and will void the product warranty.
